### **UPDATE 5/27/20:**

At present, all league activity remains suspended. We have communicated with all the team captains regarding next steps moving forward and will continue in this collaborative approach. [The previously referenced June 7<sup>th</sup> date represents the \*earliest possible\* date for the restart of league play, although we anticipate it will be a little later in the summer before things can really get going again.](#) We will continue to update as warranted.

Like all of you, One-Touch Soccer has been monitoring the current COVID-19 situation. While the Georgia Department of Public Health says that the risk of contracting COVID-19 in Georgia remains low, we certainly understand that there are concerns about this rapidly-evolving situation.

At this time, there are no significant changes to our programming at One-Touch Soccer, although we would like to ensure everyone that we are continuously monitoring the situation and will make additional announcements and/or changes to our programming as necessary. Our goal is to be proactive but without inciting any undue fears. As such, we would like to implement, with everyone's cooperation, the following:
